#### Scenario

- 3. Now think about what other ways you could have used to find the course.

Use one of them to find it, again.

- 4. Saying that you want to advance your skills beyond this one particular course, show how you would use the site to discover courses that would build on the "BMC Atrium Orchestrator 7.5: Foundation Part 2" course.
- 5. You want to **cancel a course** you have registered for. Use the site to find BMC's cancelation policy.
- 6. Use the site to find out if BMC gives rides from hotels to training centers for instructor-led training.
